



Classic race

Day: Saturday May 25th

Type of race: ECA Junior Cup, international race, Swiss Championships 2019.

Course: from Grono (Golena Pascolet) to Roveredo (200 m after the old railway bridge). WW III.

How to get there: Swiss A2 highway till Bellinzona Nord (1h10' from Milano, 2h from Zürich). Then drive on the cantonal road in the direction of San Bernardino. You will encounter the village of Lumino, San Vittore, then Roveredo. On the cantonal road you will encounter signs to the start and finish lines.

Timetable: From 2 to 3 pm official training, from 3 to 5 pm race. *Please note that there might be variations to this schedule depending on the water level.*

Sprint race

Day: Sunday May 26th

Type of race: international race

Course: River Ticino at Molinazzo Rapids. From 100 m before the rapids to the red bridge. The course is about 600-700 m long with class 3 rapids.

How to get there A2 highway, exit Bellinzona Nord (1 h 10' from Milano, 2 h from Zürich) . Then go towards Bellinzona on the cantonal road. After the village of Arbedo turn right (follow the signs)

Timetable: From 9 am to 10 am official training, from 10 am individual race, then team race.

Water level The race will be done with any water level. The race will be canceled just in case of flooding conditions.

Extreme kayak race

Day: Saturday May 25th

Type of race: international race.

Course: River Moesa, from Sorte (bridge) to Cama (bridge). WW IV+

How to get there: Swiss A2 highway till Bellinzona Nord (1h10' from Milano, 2h from Zürich). Then drive on the cantonal road in the direction of San Bernardino. You will encounter the village of Lumino, San Vittore, Roveredo, Grono then Cama. On the cantonal road you will encounter signs to the start and finish lines.

Parking: the day of the race, the athletes must park their car in the official parking located in Cama near the finish line. From there to the start there will be a shuttle bus to the start of the race riding from 10 to 12.

Timetable: From 11 am to 12 am official training, from 12 am to 1 pm race.

Categories The categories admitted to this race are K1 men and K1 women. Minimum age is 18.

Insurance Athletes not registered with a Club should have a personal insurance. For non-Swiss athletes, it is highly recommended to bring the European Health Insurance Card in order to receive the first medical Services if needed.

Registration Registrations must be done within 11 pm of Wednesday, May 22 only on-line at the website: <http://www.gipsy-soft.net/Kanu/user/login> (username: kanu, password: Kanu)The category to select is K1 Allgemein.

Participation fee: 10 CHF for each participant (payment can be done also in euro). Registered athletes which will not be at the start will pay the regular participation fee.

Bib delivery: from 9:30 to 11:30 at the finish line of the classic race in Roveredo. A deposit of 50 CHF (or 50 euro) will be requested. You can pay the participation fee together with the extras (lunch, dinner and dormitory) all together at the bib delivery.

The Santana hotel in Roveredo offers special rates for the race participants: night and breakfast for 65.- CHF per person. To reserve please directly contact the hotel.

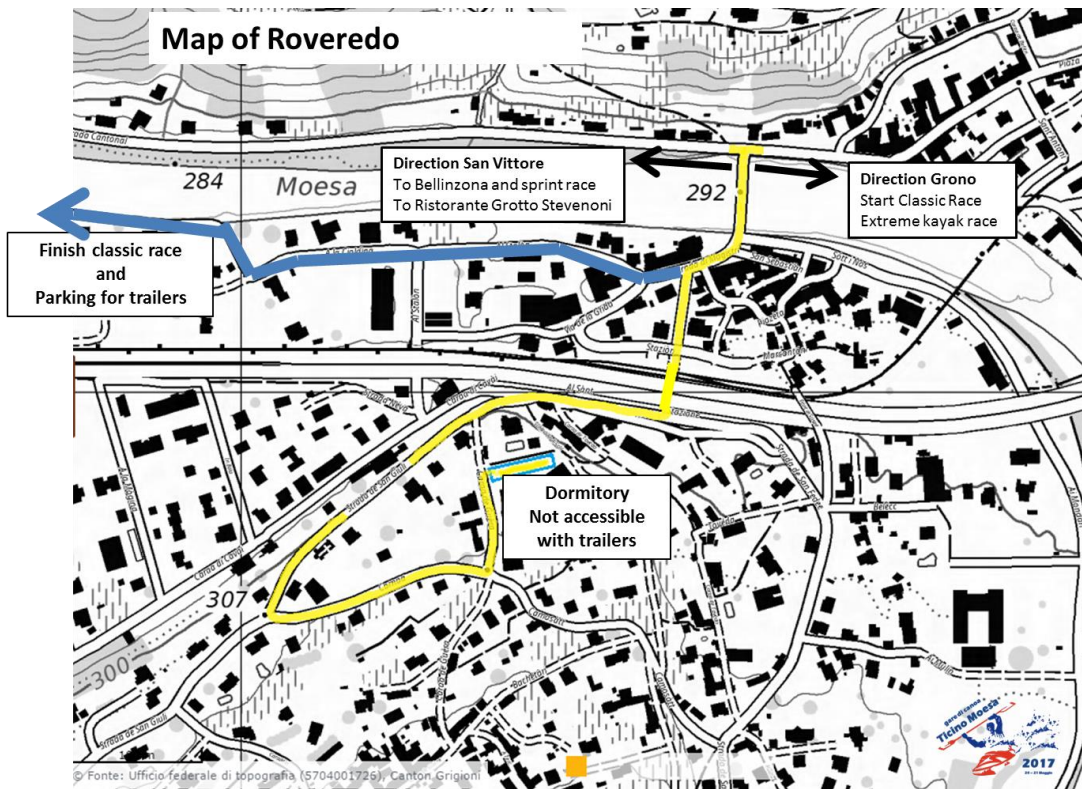
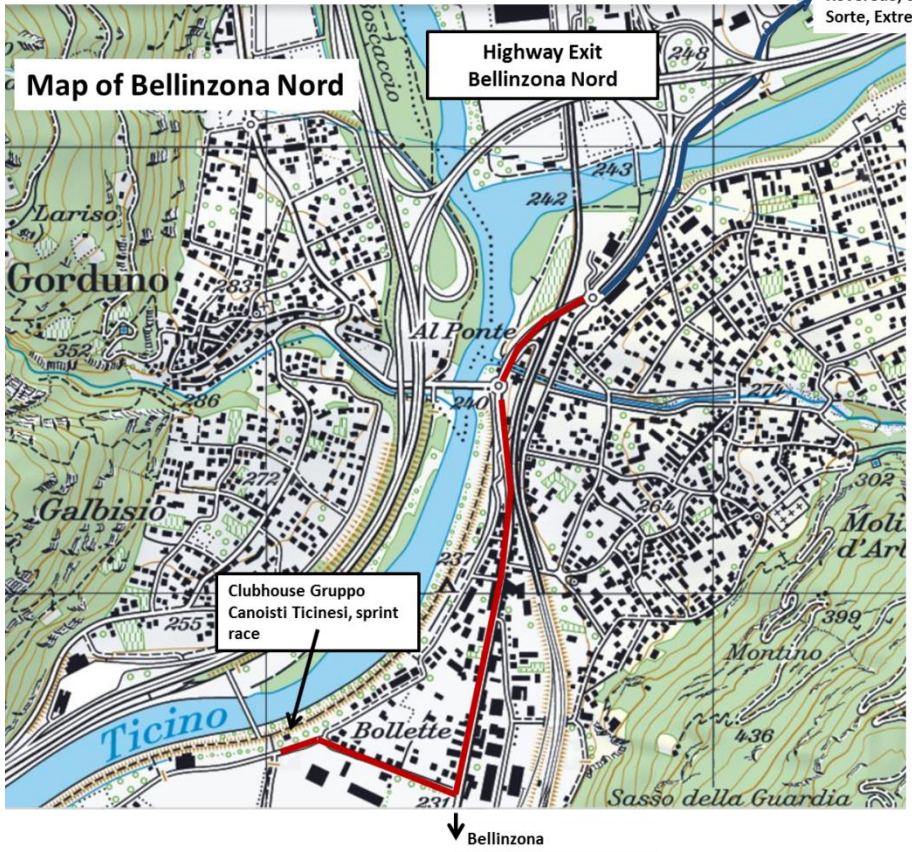
Restaurant
